

Meet the Henrys - Toronto slide guitarist and songwriter Don Rooke and some great players making Gospel music for skeptics.

'Quiet Industry' is their soon-to-be-released first album in 6 years. This time around, airy-toned master singer Gregory Hoskins does the lead vocals. If you haven't heard the Henrys before, check them out. They sound great on casual listening but whole new worlds are revealed when you tune right in.
